We support members of the Berlin University Alliance in all matters relating to open access publishing, even independently of the publication offerings in BerlinUP.

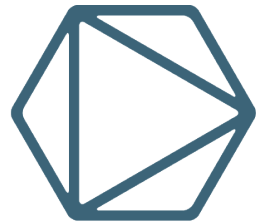

Mission Statement

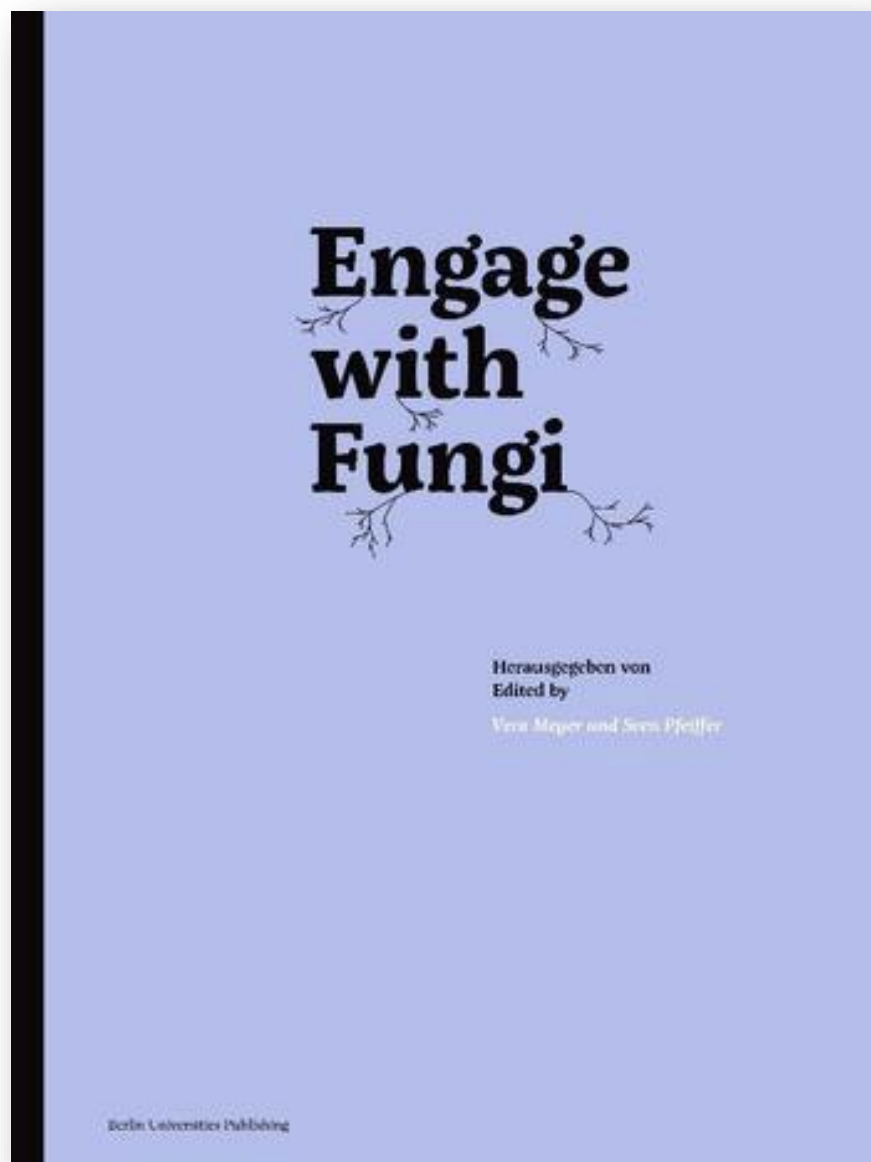
- ❖ We are an academic, **non-commercial, open access publisher** for all disciplinary fields of the Berlin research landscape.

ORCID iD

An ORCID iD ensures that you can be uniquely identified as an author. This makes it easier for research institutions, publishers, publication systems, and funding agencies to accurately attribute your research output. Additionally, you can specify affiliations, publications, and research projects, as well as link other profiles and websites.

Authorship and affiliation

For publications and other research results, you indicate your name for authorship, as well as the name of your institution(s), the so-called affiliation. We provide instructions on how to indicate the affiliation correctly.

Are you faced with the question of how to publish your dissertation? We describe the publication options.

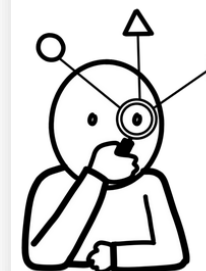

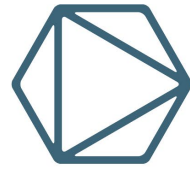
