

The three components of a quotation

In Text Bei dem Verarbeiten wissenschaftlicher Literatur ist es
(Example) wichtig zwischen relevanter und nicht relevanter
Literatur zu unterscheiden (EBEL et al. 2012, S. 447).

(1) The quoted statement

This can either be reproduced unchanged (direct quotation) or, as in this example, reformulated (indirect quotation).

(2) The short reference

A compact reference in the text. It is usually placed in brackets.

(3) The full reference

A detailed list of sources at the end of the paper.
