

The three components of a quotation

(1) The quoted statement

This can either be reproduced unchanged (direct quotation) or, as in this example, reformulated (indirect quotation).

(2) The short reference

A compact reference in the text. It
is usually placed in brackets.

(Example) and W. Greulich. *Schreiben und Publizieren in den
Naturwissenschaften*. Wiley, Weinheim, 2012.

(3) The full reference

A detailed list of sources at the end
of the paper.
