Cosmic dust falls everywhere. It is on our streets, in our homes and even on our clothes. This talk will show how cosmic dust (micrometeorites) has been collected from roof tops in urban areas and what it tells us about our solar system.



Matt Genge is a senior lecturer at Imperial College in London. He is an expert in cosmic dust and was a scientist on the NASA Stardust mission. He did a PhD on carbonatite volcanoes at UCL in London and then worked at the Natural History Museum in London on meteorites.
